PRESIDENT'S STATEMENT

It is such a pleasure this year to have time to step back & share a real sense of pride and accomplishment with the other hardworking members of the CSAG Board. Together with the growing number of volunteers & members who support the Cowichan South Arts Guild in its goals, we have made huge strides!! Consistency & sustainability in programming have been priority, as well as *getting the word out* through our new & improved website, local publications, word of mouth, and our bi-weekly **Creative Pulse** updates & annual **H'Artbeat Reflections**.

By building a sense of connection & appreciation for our volunteers we strive to build teams who will return year after year to help with the annual events that are making their mark in the South Cowichan. Beginning its third season, both the monthly **Acoustic Jam** & the weekly **Inspire!**Youth Art Tent (summer) have been hugely successful with unexpectedly large numbers of participants joining us regularly. We continue to offer all the drop in programs from 2022, with fair to good attendance depending on the season, a testament to the sustainability of our choices, and we actively monitor each program with monthly reports, to see where we can adjust to be sure we are serving our community successfully.

We have refined our vision over the past 4 years offering a late Winter gathering, previously called 'Once Upon a Time', & have shifted to offering, in partnership with Shawnigan Museum, our 2nd season of 'The Art of Storytelling', an all ages weekend event focused on oral storytelling. With good-sized enthusiastic audiences last year, we anticipate from the positive feedback we received that this year will continue to draw good with South Cowichan Music Jam & the Malahat Legion – a monthly opportunity for local semi professional musicians to connect & jam informally on stage together. This happily adds another partnership for CSAG in the South Cowichan area, & has proven to already be a mutually beneficial connection for all 3 organizations!

An exciting new project which is on its way towards completion this spring is the **Community Art Caravan**, which emerged from the vision of creating a portable home base for CSAG, which, while happily & successfully sharing space in a variety of locations with various other organizations, will now proudly be able to store, transport, display & even offer some workshops out of the creative, whimsical little arts home, while travelling to a variety of locations around the valley.

All in all, CSAG has grown significantly, & our challenge now will be to remain sustainable by finding grants that will help us pay for admin staff to support the committed & enthusiastic volunteer team currently carrying the large load!

Facilitated opportunity for music lovers to connect & play together in a relaxed setting.
